Description: Cast censer with six-sided profiled base transitioning into a six-sided stem. On top the round vessel decorated with grunts. Both the top edge of the barrel and the lower edge of the openwork domed lid each have four eyelets for the (disappeared) chains. The lid has two openwork stops on which a likewise openwork lantern towers, all referring to Gothic architecture. The crowning of the lantern is also an eye for a (disappeared) chain.
