Origin: The young, somewhat chubby, Mary stands in a slight hip position. Her long wavy hair falls over her shoulders. The face is broad and serious. The right hand is raised, thumb and index finger touching. The baby Jesus sits on her left arm. The baby Jesus blesses and holds in left hand a globe. Mary's robe is dark over which is a white upper garment trimmed around the neck with precious stones and at the hem with pearls. The cloak is also trimmed with pearls. The rich pleating gives the image a certain monumentality. But it is also very delicately executed, like the hair and the pearl-adorned borders.
