Description: In the center, Mary mourns the death of her son Jesus. Beside her, richly dressed, is Mary Magdalene, recognizable by the ointment jar. Furthermore, the two Marys. The dead body is supported by the apostle John. In an imaginary landscape is the city of Jerusalem and Golgotha where the three crosses are visible. The mannerist style betrays an Antwerp origin, possibly from the environment of the Master of the Adoration von Groote who was active there in the first quarter of the 16th century.
