

*Pentecost / Evangelist Mark* (inv. 00211)

Description: The choir of a church represents the cenacle where Mary, with a book on her lap, and the apostles have taken their seats. The Holy Spirit, in the form of a dove, descends upon them at Pentecost. The vault of the building rests on four columns with capitals above which are statues. On the backside is St. Mark with his gospel, seated before a brocade hanging with at his feet a lion, his symbol with a banderole on which is written 'St. Mark'.
