Description: An oval alabaster relief depicts St. Mark seated on his symbol, a lion. On his lap, the evangelist holds an open book and turns to an inkwell above the lion's head. The cracked alabaster is encased in an eight-sided wooden frame with hollow moulding and ebony veneer. From the same series, St. Luke is kept in the collection.
